EN Preparing the Camera

Inserting the battery and the SD/SDHC memory card (sold separately)

- Always use SD/SDHC memory cards with this camera. Do not insert any other types of memory card.



- Insert the battery by putting in the ▼ marked side first, with the ● marks toward the battery lock knob. Damage to the battery exterior (scratches, etc.) may produce heat or an explosion.
- Turn off the camera before opening the battery/card compartment cover.
- When using the camera, be sure to close the battery/card compartment cover.
- Insert the card straight until it clicks into place.
- Do not touch the contact area directly.



Charging the battery and setting up using the supplied CD

Connect the camera to the computer to charge the battery and use the supplied CD for setup.

- User registration using the supplied CD and installation of its computer software is available on Windows computers only.

The camera battery can be charged while the camera is connected to a computer.

Windows

- We recommend that you use a computer equipped with Windows XP (Service Pack 2 or later), Windows Vista, or Windows 7.

1 Insert the supplied CD in a CD-ROM drive.

Windows XP

- A "Setup" dialog will be displayed.

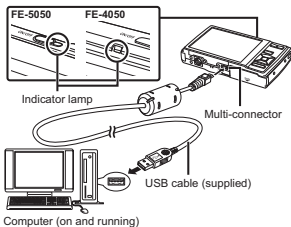
Windows Vista/Windows 7

- An Autorun dialog will be displayed. Click "OLYMPUS Setup" to display the "Setup" dialog.
- If the "Setup" dialog is not displayed, select "My Computer" (Windows XP) or "Computer" (Windows Vista/Windows 7) from the start menu. Double-click the CD-ROM (OLYMPUS Setup) icon to open the "OLYMPUS Setup" window and then double-click "SETUP.EXE".
- If a "User Account Control" dialog is displayed, click "Yes" or "Continue".

2 Follow the on-screen instructions on your computer.

- If nothing is displayed on the camera screen even after connecting the camera to the computer, the battery may be exhausted. Leave the camera connected to the computer until the battery has charged, then disconnect and reconnect the camera.

Connecting the camera



- When the camera is connected to another device via USB, a message will be displayed prompting you to choose a connection type. Select [STORAGE].

3 Register your Olympus product.

- Click the "Registration" button and follow the on-screen instructions.

4 Install the camera manual.

- Click the "Camera Instruction Manual" button and follow the on-screen instructions.

Macintosh

- Mac OS X v10.4.11~v10.6

1 Insert the supplied CD in a CD-ROM drive.

- Double-click the CD (OLYMPUS Setup) icon on the desktop.

2 Copy the camera manual.

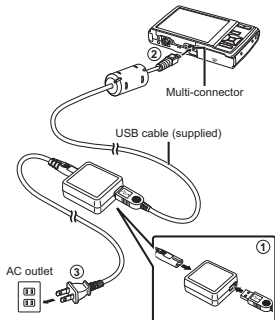
- Click the "Camera Instruction Manual" button to open the folder containing the camera manuals. Copy the manual for your language to the computer.

Charging the battery with the supplied USB-AC adapter

- 1 The included F-2AC USB-AC adapter (with an AC cable or plug-in type; hereafter referred to as USB-AC adapter) differs depending on the region where you purchased the camera. If you received a plug-in type USB-AC adapter, plug it directly into an AC outlet.

Example: USB-AC adapter with an AC cable

1



- 1 When the camera is connected to another device via USB, a message will be displayed prompting you to choose a connection type. Select [CHARGE].
- 2 The battery is not fully charged at the time of purchase. Before use, be sure to charge the battery until the indicator lamp turns off (up to 3 hours).
- 3 If the indicator lamp does not light, the camera is not correctly connected or the battery, camera, or USB-AC adapter may not be functioning as expected.

Date, time, time zone, and language

- 1 Press the ON/OFF button to turn on the camera.
- The date and time setting screen is displayed when the date and time are not set.
- 2 Use $\Delta \nabla$ to select the year for [Y].
- 3 Press \triangleright to save the setting for [Y].
- 4 As in Steps 2 and 3, use $\Delta \nabla \langle \triangleright$ and the OK button to set [M] (month), [D] (day), [TIME] (hours and minutes), and [Y/M/D] (date order).
- 5 Use $\langle \triangleright$ to select your home time zone and press the OK button.
- Use $\Delta \nabla$ to turn daylight saving time ([SUMMER]) on or off.
- 6 Use $\Delta \nabla \langle \triangleright$ to select your language and press the OK button.

Shooting with the optimum aperture value and shutter speed [PROGRAM AUTO]

- 1 Press the ON/OFF button to turn on the camera.
- 1 If the [PROGRAM AUTO] indicator is not displayed, press the OK button to display the function menu and then set the shooting mode to P.
- 1 Press the ON/OFF button again to turn off the camera.
- 2 Hold the camera and compose the shot.
- 3 Press the shutter button halfway down to focus on the subject.
- When the camera focuses on the subject, the exposure is locked (shutter speed and aperture value are displayed), and the AF target mark changes to green.
 - The camera was unable to focus if the AF target mark flashes red. Try focusing again.
- 4 To take the picture, gently press the shutter button all the way down while being careful not to shake the camera.

Using the flash

- 1 Select the flash option in the shooting function menu.
- 2 Use $\langle \triangleright$ to select the setting option, and press the OK button to set.

Viewing images

- 1 Press the \triangleright button.
- 2 Use $\langle \triangleright$ to select an image.

Erasing images during playback (Single image erase)

- 1 Display the image you want to erase and press ∇ (U).
- 2 Press $\Delta \nabla$ to select [ERASE], and press the OK button.

General Precautions

Read All Instructions — Before you use the product, read all operating instructions. Save all manuals and documentation for future reference.

Cleaning — Always unplug this product from the wall outlet before cleaning. Use only a damp cloth for cleaning. Never use any type of liquid or aerosol cleaner, or any type of organic solvent to clean this product.

Attachments — For your safety, and to avoid damaging the product, use only accessories recommended by Olympus.

Water and Moisture — For precautions on products with weatherproof designs, read the weatherproofing sections.

Location — To avoid damage to the product, mount the product securely on a stable tripod, stand, or bracket.

Power Source — Connect this product only to the power source described on the product label.

Lightning — If a lightning storm occurs while using a USB-AC adapter, remove it from the wall outlet immediately.

Foreign Objects — To avoid personal injury, never insert a metal object into the product.

Heat — Never use or store this product near any heat source such as a radiator, heat register, stove, or any type of equipment or appliance that generates heat, including stereo amplifiers.

Handling the Camera



WARNING

- Do not use the camera near flammable or explosive gases.
- Do not use the flash and LED on people (infants, small children, etc.) at close range.
 - You must be at least 1 m (3 ft.) away from the faces of your subjects. Firing the flash too close to the subject's eyes could cause a momentary loss of vision.
- Keep young children and infants away from the camera.
 - Always use and store the camera out of the reach of young children and infants to prevent the following dangerous situations which could cause serious injury:
 - Becoming entangled in the camera strap, causing strangulation.
 - Accidentally swallowing the battery, cards or other small parts.
 - Accidentally firing the flash into their own eyes or those of another child.
 - Accidentally being injured by the moving parts of the camera.
- Do not look at the sun or strong lights with the camera.
- Do not use or store the camera in dusty or humid places.
- Do not cover the flash with a hand while firing.
- Use SD/SDHC memory cards only. Never use other types of cards.

If you accidentally insert another type of card into the camera, contact an authorized distributor or service center. Do not try to remove the card by force.



CAUTION

- Stop using the camera immediately if you notice any unusual odors, noise, or smoke around it.
 - Never remove the batteries with bare hands, which may cause a fire or burn your hands.
- Never hold or operate the camera with wet hands.
- Do not leave the camera in places where it may be subject to extremely high temperatures.
 - Doing so may cause parts to deteriorate and, in some circumstances, cause the camera to catch fire. Do not use the charger or USB-AC adapter if it is covered (such as a blanket). This could cause overheating, resulting in fire.
- Handle the camera with care to avoid getting a low-temperature burn.
 - When the camera contains metal parts, overheating can result in a low-temperature burn. Pay attention to the following:
 - When used for a long period, the camera will get hot. If you hold on to the camera in this state, a low-temperature burn may be caused.
 - In places subject to extremely cold temperatures, the temperature of the camera's body may be lower than the environmental temperature. If possible, wear gloves when handling the camera in cold temperatures.
- Be careful with the strap.
 - Be careful with the strap when you carry the camera. It could easily catch on stray objects and cause serious damage.

Battery Handling Precautions

Follow these important guidelines to prevent batteries from leaking, overheating, burning, exploding, or causing electrical shocks or burns.

DANGER

- The camera uses a lithium ion battery specified by Olympus. Charge the battery with the specified USB-AC adapter or charger. Do not use any other USB-AC adapters or chargers.
- Never heat or incinerate batteries.
- Take precautions when carrying or storing batteries to prevent them from coming into contact with any metal objects such as jewelry, pins, fasteners, etc.
- Never store batteries where they will be exposed to direct sunlight, or subjected to high temperatures in a hot vehicle, near a heat source, etc.
- To prevent causing battery leaks or damaging their terminals, carefully follow all instructions regarding the use of batteries. Never attempt to disassemble a battery or modify it in any way, solder, etc.
- If battery fluid gets into your eyes, flush your eyes immediately with clear, cold running water and seek medical attention immediately.
- Always store batteries out of the reach of small children. If a child accidentally swallows a battery, seek medical attention immediately.

WARNING

- Keep batteries dry at all times.
- To prevent batteries from leaking, overheating, or causing a fire or explosion, use only batteries recommended for use with this product.
- Insert the battery carefully as described in the operating instructions.
- If rechargeable batteries have not been recharged within the specified time, stop charging them and do not use them.
- Do not use a battery if it is cracked or broken.
- If a battery leaks, becomes discolored or deformed, or becomes abnormal in any other way during operation, stop using the camera.
- If a battery leaks fluid onto your clothing or skin, remove the clothing and flush the affected area with clean, running cold water immediately. If the fluid burns your skin, seek medical attention immediately.
- Never subject batteries to strong shocks or continuous vibration.

CAUTION

- Before loading, always inspect the battery carefully for leaks, discoloration, warping, or any other abnormality.
- The battery may become hot during prolonged use. To avoid minor burns, do not remove it immediately after using the camera.
- Always unload the battery from the camera before storing the camera for a long period.
